Clinic Medical Director Update:



The clinic numbers are moving up, last year in December the total visits were 123, this year is141.

The clinic is seeing new patients coming into Point Roberts including children. Covid, RSV and influenza has eased up. The staff have been conducting house visits on a case-by-case basis (reserving the right to choose which one of the patients require a home visit) but it is not being advertised.

Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Bozorgzadeh is advocating on behalf of Point Roberts and lobbying to get better coverage for hospice. He met with the director of one of the hospice services in Whatcom County and is trying to setup a relationship where they can use their medical director for hospice but SuperTrack would like to stay involved with the care of their patients. Dr. Bozorgzadeh wanted to lay the groundwork and ensure they have a working relationship with them.

Hospice requires that life expectancy is less than 4 months and in some cases 6 months. The reimbursement is covered better through insurance companies where they can afford to come to Point Roberts. It seems to be that reimbursement for sending a nurse to a home where for example they just had surgery or an illness, is not covered well. It's not enough coverage or reimbursement for these companies to invest in hiring nurses and sending them to a remote location such as Point Roberts for a house call.

<u>Holiday celebration update:</u> Due to Covid and RSV illnesses the Christmas party was cancelled. Gift baskets were handed out to the Lakeway location and Barbara brought gift cards for the Point Roberts staff.

<u>Return to in-person meetings:</u> Stephen prefers using ZOOM for a few more months. The commissioners will meet with Paulette at the Marina Office to sign documents if needed.
