Clinic Medical Director Update:

<u>Clinic Update:</u> Dr. Kelly Evans is on board now and things have gone smoothly. There are somethings they are working on to get for her that is particular to her practice.

The vaccine clinic for children is this Friday for those that qualify. Pfizer is the vaccine being offered. Have held 2 flu clinics and will be having another one. Almost out of the flu vaccine so another 50 doses have been ordered. It takes 3-4 days to get the flu vaccines once they are ordered.

The free antibiotics have arrived and Dr. Bozorgzad will provide the antibiotic list that was ordered for the clinic at the next meeting. This will reduce the number of border crossings necessary for residents to receive medications.

Superintendent's Report:

<u>Election Results for PRPHD Position 3:</u> Kandace has 1 more meeting to attend, Sara Oggel will take over in January. The official election result will be certified on the 23rd.



<u>Update on CNA Insurance Reinstatement/PSF Assistance:</u> The county is working with the banks to have the money returned to our account. Meredith Jones, the Insurance Agent with Parker, Smith & Feeks, has succeeded with getting CNA to agree to reinstate the policy. Paulette is working with the county to have the check processed based on the vote passed at the last meeting. Meredith is having CNA fill out a new W-9 due to the fact that the address we have listed is not correct and we do not have the correct address on file.

Weekly Covid test updates from Chief Carleton: The weekly Covid testing continues and has expanded exponentially due to the border reopening. Many Canadians are returning to their cottages and staying. Chief Carleton has been deluged with calls, emails and doesn't always remember to send the weekly data. Barbara does remind him so she can get the information to the folks at the Community Center so they can decide the status of opening the Commons, Historical Society, etc. To date there are 0 positive cases.

<u>Status of 2022 Budget Draft:</u> The 2022 Budget Meeting was announced as required. Barbara and Paulette will be meeting tomorrow.

Per Stephen, we are not quite there yet to have hybrid meetings. There are still some technology issues to deal with.

Research Partnership Proposal from Measure Labs, Seattle - Stephen Falk:

Jamie Leitzinger from Measure Labs in Seattle is looking for companies to assist with a technology testing project. Measure Labs uses AI to generate readings via a smartphone which will then report the information to doctors. For example, blood pressure readings. Measure Labs is seeking a couple thousand hypertensive patients in order to make the algorithms accurate. Dr. Bozorgzad didn't feel the Clinic's volume of patients is high enough for the technology testing.
